Adverbs give extra meaning to a verb, an adjective or a whole sentence.

E.g. He walks slowly.

conjunctions

Used to join a new sentence to the previous.
E.g. We went to the park and played on the swings. Then we had an ice cream.

Suffip

A group of letters added to the end of a word to change its grammatical use.

E.g. call - called teach - teacher play - plaful

Prefip

A group of letters
added to the front of
a word to change its
grammatical use. E.g.
Dismiss
Untidy
Inedible
