



Interested in volunteering in school? | Quick guide

Volunteers from the community play an important role in supporting our children's learning and help us provide children with a variety of different opportunities and experiences.

Level 1 Volunteer

"I just want to help on the occasional trip with my class or come into class to read a story."

Great - speak to your child's class teacher who can explain the next steps.

Please be aware that if you come into school you will need to provide a form of photographic I.D. and if helping on a trip you may not be working directly with your child.

Level 2 Volunteer

"I would like to come in a couple of times a term to read a story, teach something I am interested in or help out with reading."

Excellent - speak to your child's class teacher who can explain the next steps.

Please be aware that if you come into school you will need to provide a form of photographic I.D. and if you would like to volunteer more regularly than three times a month you will need to become a level 3 volunteer for safeguarding purposes.

Level 3 Volunteer

"I would like to come in every week to read with the children or get experience of working in a school."

Brilliant - speak to your child's class teacher who will pass your information onto our volunteer coordinator Sandra Scott. She will talk you through the process of becoming a level 3 volunteer in our school.
